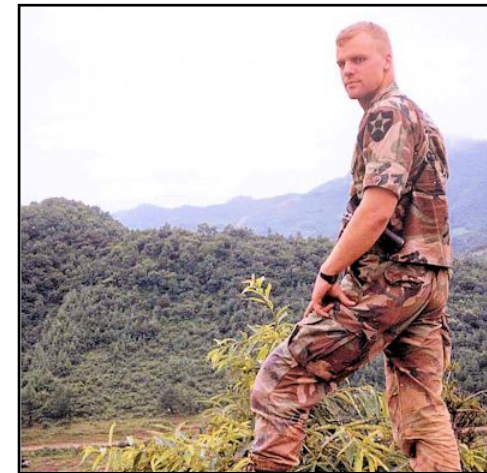

“I’ll start by thanking Korean War vets and the KWVA for giving us Korea Defense Veterans a home. It is truly appreciated. For almost twenty years now I have been silent regarding my service in Korea (1987/1988). When I was stationed in Korea, I would tell my future wife or others back home of firefights along the DMZ, infiltration attempts, soldiers picked off by snipers and riots in the streets, only to be told that there was no word of any of it in the states.

During the first few months after returning from Korea, I attempted to tell others of my experiences in Korea, only to get a blank stare or a look of disbelief. It didn’t take long for me to just quit talking about it with anyone but those who had been there. It was, and still is, a tour of duty no one understands, especially our media, who does not deem this service newsworthy.

Korea defense service remains a unique—but virtually unknown—cold war type of duty. At times this duty goes hot. This article is dedicated to the 1,200 American soldiers who gave their lives in the line of duty from July 1954 to now in North or South Korea. To date, neither their names nor their service have been recognized...”
