THE FOLLOWING ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS APPLY

1. Any World War II veteran. (Has to be eligible for World War II Victory Medal) Include a copy of discharge & Separation.
2. Korean War veteran who served in Korea or adjacent waters during the conflict, 1950-1954. (Has to be eligible for the Korean Service Medal ~~and must have been awarded a Purple Heart for injuries~~)
3. Vietnam War veteran who served in Vietnam or adjacent waters during the conflict, 1965-1973. (Has to be eligible for the Vietnam Service Medal ~~and must have been awarded a Purple Heart for injuries~~)
4. Wounded Veteran of the War on Terrorism, 9/11/2001 to present. ~~(Must have been awarded a Purple Heart for injuries)~~
