Expanded Eligibility

Korean War veterans and / or family members of one who served in, over or around the Korean theater between June 25, 1950 and October 15, 1954 are eligible to participate in

the "Korea Revisit Program." A veteran is allowed to bring a family member or friend as a "travel companion". Widows and/or descendants are also eligible. If a Veteran or family member has been back to Korea on a previous subsidized tour that took place over five (5) years ago and would like to go again, please contact us for details.

We believe the Korean government will continue to subsidize the veterans & family members/companion airfare for the 60th Anniversaries, in addition to already paying for hotel, meals and touring in Korea.

There will be major ceremonies throughout 2011 commemorating the *important battles and campaigns of 1951. Demand was great in 2010 with sold out Revisits with 600+ participants, so register for 2011 now!*

- * Be at least eighteen (18) years old (waivers for 17 year-old high school graduates.)
- * Be in "relatively" good health.
- * Have a current passport.
- * 2011 dates pending from ROK.
- * Their will be approximately 25 in each group & will have a tour escort.

2010 PCFY with Secretaries Clinton & Gates

- * **All expense's for the grand-child** while in Korea, will be paid for by the ROK government (Double occupancy.) Each tour participant will be required to pay 1/2 of his/her air fare. (The ROK will pay the other half.)
- * Service of charge of \$400.
- * All programs are conducted in English.



Beijing (China) Post-Tour Itinerary

(Optional—day order varies with each group)

Day 1 - Arrival, orientation, bus tour around “*Tian An Men Square*” and Legation area. Check-in and Welcome to China Peking Duck dinner.

Day 2 - Walking tour of the *Forbidden City* and the Palace Museum, “*Temple of Heaven*”, silk factory tour, special acrobatic show this evening.

Day 3 - “*Great Wall of China*”, Cloisonné factory tour, friendship store.

Day 4 - “*The Summer Palace*” Beijing Zoo Pandas (largest collection in captivity), Pearl Factory tour, Chinese Opera (optional).

Day 5 - Walking tour of “*Tian An Men*” Square, “*Hutong Rickshaw tour*” through the labyrinth of old Beijing neighborhoods. Special lunch with a traditional Chinese Hutong family and Jade Fac-



tory tour. Evening Farewell Dinner, those extending onto Xian depart on overnight train.

Xian Extension Itinerary

Day 6 - Arrive Xian, check into hotel for breakfast. Afternoon visit the ancient “*Xian City Wall*” and “*Wild Goose Buddhist*” Temple. Tang Dynasty Song and Dance Dinner Show.

Day 7 - Visit the world famous “*Terra Cotta Soldier Museum*”, then witness the painstaking workmanship that went into producing the Emperor’s porcelain army at a “*Terra Cotta Factory*”. In the afternoon fly from Xian to Beijing and transfer to hotel.

Day 8 - After breakfast, transfer to airport for flight to Seoul on to LAX.
