Membership Still at 90, but...!

Year-end membership grew to 90 Active Members with the addition of **Bill Sherwood** at our Christmas Luncheon. Despite adding **Dave Sinai** and **Gloria Corbet** in January, our membership stays at 90 bona fide Association members because so far, two members did not renew.

Thanks to **2nd VP Don Lynch**, who has called members with expiring due dates, several have submitted their renewals who may not have otherwise done so (see related article, page 6).

Now is a critical time for member renewal: eleven (11) are payable immediately, four (4) in February and twelve (12) in March.

Our membership policy is to remove members from the Chapter rolls when they become inactive on Membership DB, one month after their Association due date.

Keep in mind that we subtract 30 days from your Association Due Date to calculate your Chapter Due Date in order to process your payment to Membership in Illinois. TJT
