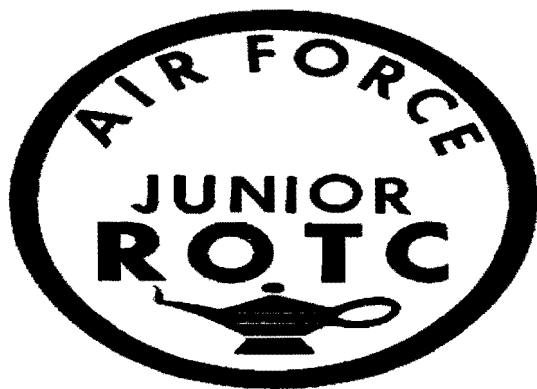

All cadets enrolled in the AFJROTC program are considered for an invitation to join this honor society. Invitations are extended to students of good character who have an overall grade point average of 3.2 or above with no failing grades and an "A" average in their AFJROTC courses. In order to remain an active member of the Kitty Hawk Air Society, these standards must be maintained by the cadet. If the standards are not maintained, they will be placed on probation or expelled from membership.

Currently, staff positions are limited to the positions of executive officer, finance officer, administrative officer and public affairs officers. The commander of KHAS is normally a senior cadet and the four positions above are filled by upcoming juniors.
